Impact Report: Board Support Program 2023–24

Introduction

The average pass percentage at 10th level of four government schools under Diyun Block has been less than 20 percent over the years.

In preparation for CBSE Board Exam 2024 the District Administration, Changlang district and India Foundation for Education Transformation (IFET) had come up with a yearlong comprehensive and holistic plan to help students prepare and pass their boards exams at their 10th level.

Program Overview

The Board Support program was implemented in two least performing government schools as a pilot for academic year 2023-24 from August 2023 to conclusion of CBSE Board Exam i.e. 14 March 2024 for students of government secondary schools, Dumapather and Government secondary School, Gautampur benefitting 106 students.

Program Components:

Academic Support

Intensive coaching in core subjects provided by experienced tutors hired by IFET. Regular practice tests and mock exams conducted to assess students' progress.

Pastoral Care

To ensure complete pastoral care and supervision of students' activities during the exam period from 10 February to 14 March 2024 separate residential set ups were arranged for boys and girls with comfortable food and lodging arrangements during the exam duration.

Collaborative Efforts:

Collaboration with local administration for ration support and accommodations provided by government, civil society bodies, student body, well wishers and most importantly our mentors and supporters.

Engagement and Motivation:

The program fostered a sense of positive competition and motivation among students, encouraging them to strive for success.

Outcome-Results

CBSE results were declared on 13 May 2024. Students at Government Secondary School, Gautampur and Government Secondary School, Dumpather both under Diyun Circle in Changlang district, achieved their highest-ever results with pass percentages of 58% and 52%, respectively. This significant improvement in students' performance in the Class X CBSE 2024 Board exams comes after several years of consistently low pass percentages, with results for class X schools falling below 12% in previous years.

Why this year's results is groundbreaking one?



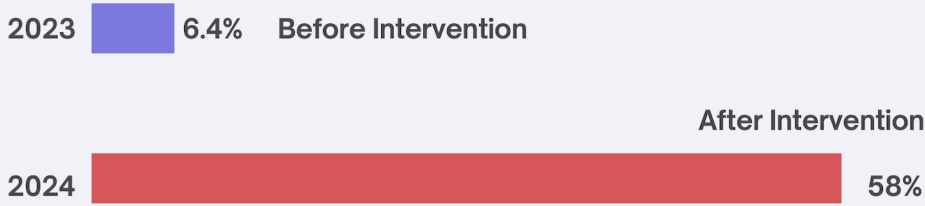
Even though it may appear from the outside that these two schools have only secured a pass percentage of less than 60 % anyway, which is not a big deal. However, given the student's low learning levels and learning gaps ridden with lack of severe English proficiency and lack of basic Maths and core subject knowledge foundation which have built over the years due to lack of foundation years and then finally overcoming all these learning challenges to then passing the board exam is itself a life changing milestone for these students to keep them motivated and on path towards a brighter career path.



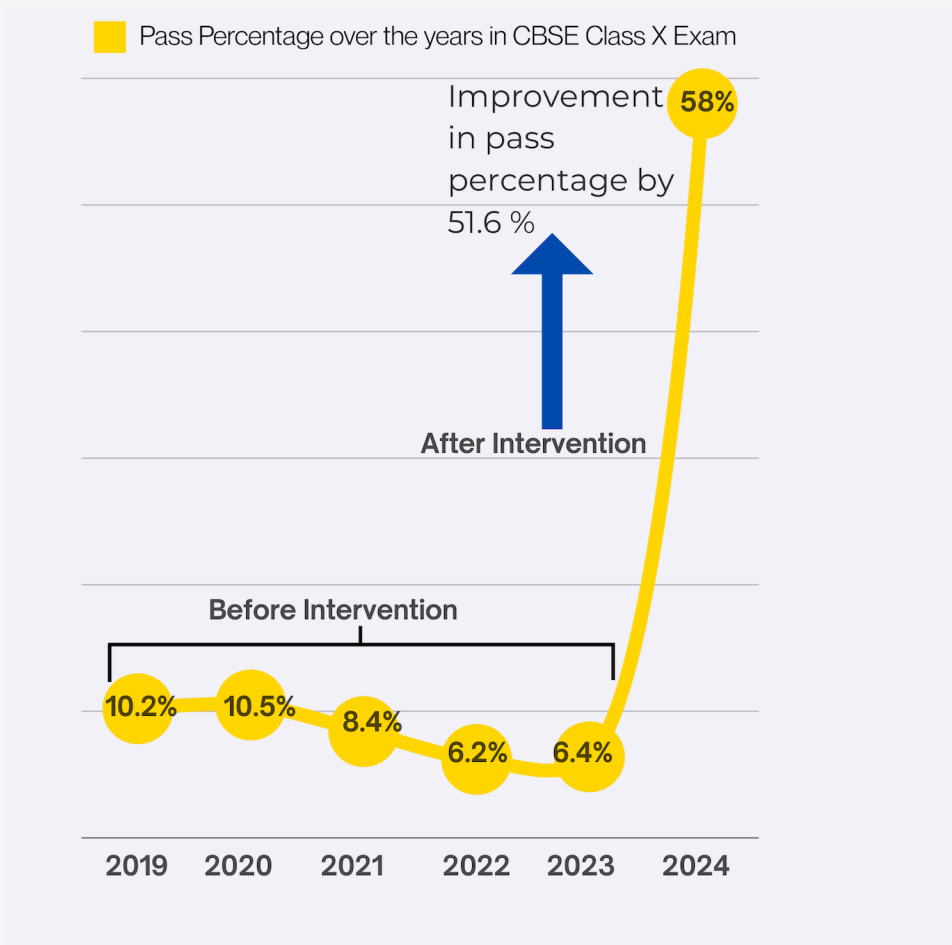

Pass Percentage improvement from 2023 to 2024 after our intervention



In CBSE Exam 2023, only 4 students passed from Government Secondary School, Gautampur, resulting in a meager pass percentage of 6.9%. However, after our intervention in CBSE Exam 2024, with 26 students passing directly, the pass percentage surged to 58%. If the students under compartment pass their papers, we will achieve a final pass percentage of more than 90%.

As per CBSE data, taking the passing percentages from 2019 to 2023, the average pass rate of GSS, Gautampur was below 9%.

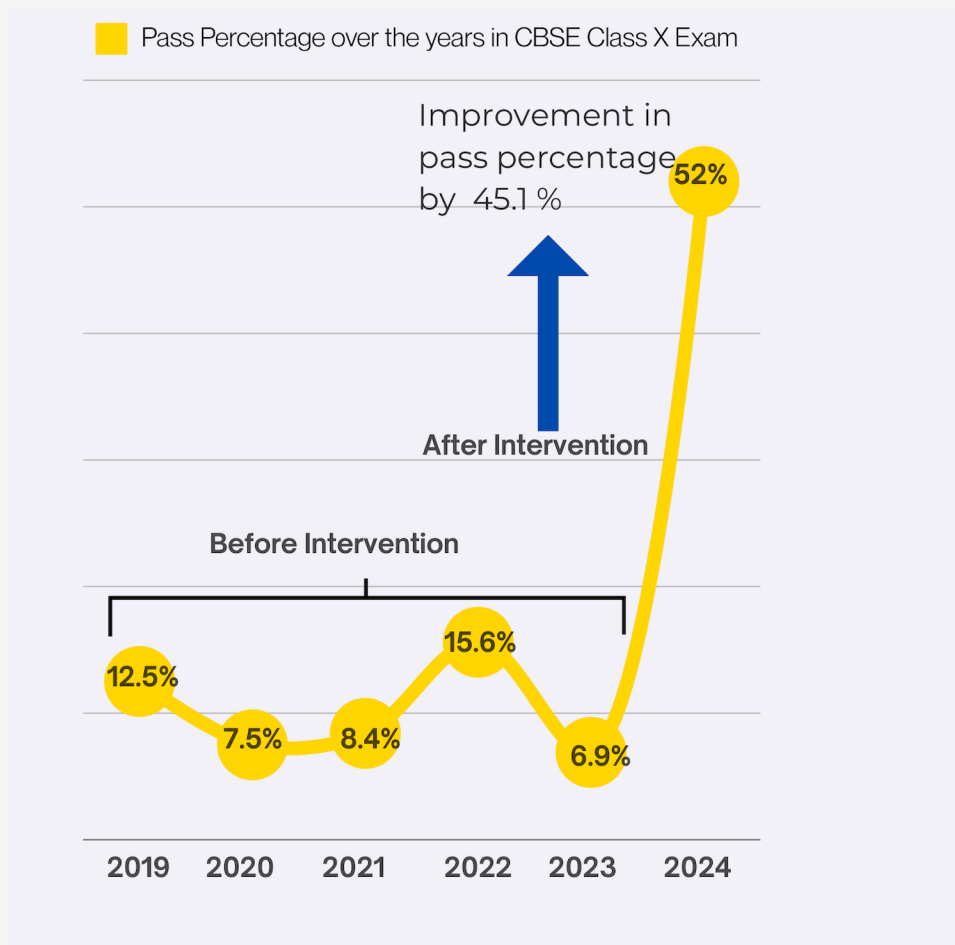

Pass Percentage improvement from 2023 to 2024 after our intervention



In CBSE Exam 2023 only 3 students had passed from Government Secondary School, Dumpather, making the overall pass percentage a meagre 6.9%. After our intervention this year in CBSE Exam 2024 the pass percentage surged to 52% with a total of 27 students who passed directly. If the students under compartment pass their papers we will achieve final pass percentage of more than 90 %.

This significant improvement in students' performance in the Class X CBSE 2024 Board exams comes after several years of consistently low pass percentages, with results for GSS, Dumpather has been little over 10% as recorded from 2019 to 2023 time period.
