MASS PLANTATION AND TREE ADOPTION DRIVE

As a part of our action towards working together to ensure nature is conserved, sustainably used and restored, together with Diyun Circle Administration, Forest Department, IFET planted over 100 saplings in and around the premises of 5 government schools.

The mass plantation and adoption drive kicked off at Government Primary School, Jyotnapur. Mr Roy, EAC, Diyun Circle and 4 officials from the Forest Department graced the program. Mr. Purnosen, Village Headman of Jyotnapur, Mr. Ashok Kr C, Headmaster of Jyotnapur Govt School also attended the program.

Going by this year's UNEP's theme of "Living Sustainably with Nature", Mr Roy, EAC, Diyun stressed on to identify local issues that are impacting the local habitat and taking actions on them. In order to ensure that the saplings grow into vibrant trees and to bring in ownership, all the trees have been fenced and adopted.

Some plants have been planted in the Diyun Township area as well.

It may be noted over the last three weeks, under IFET's initiatives, more than 200 saplings are planted.
